Save the date: Synod Listening Session at Holy Family Church, Syracuse on Monday, February 7, 2022 from 6:30 to 8:30PM.

Pope Francis has called for a World Synod of Bishops for October of 2023. In preparation for that meeting in 2023 Pope Francis wants consult with bishops, priests, and laity and journey together to seek the will of Holy Spirit for the Church. To this end, bishops around the world are holding listening sessions to hear from people their thoughts, hopes, visions for the Church. Everyone is invited to the listening session at Holy Family Church on Monday, February 7, 2022 from 6:30 to 8:30 PM. Bishop Lucia will be present to listen to your comments on the life of the Church in the Diocese of Syracuse. This listening session is open to our Pastoral Care Area, which includes St. Joseph's Church, Camillus, St. Patrick's, Jordan, St. Mary's, Skaneateles, St. Francis Xavier, Marcellus, St. Michael's, Onondaga Hill, and Holy Family. In addition, it is open to all people from across the Diocese. Again, the goal of these sessions is to hear from you. I strongly encourage everyone to attend and to know that your voice matters. Information from these listening sessions will be shared with our Holy Father Pope Francis.

I hope and pray you will put this date on your calendar and that you will come and gather with others from around our area to talk about our faith!
