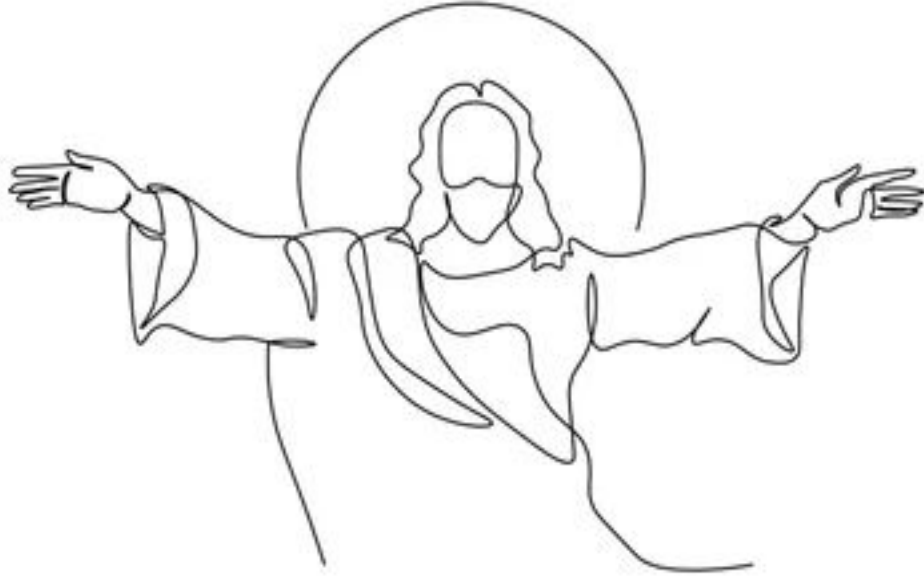

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Holy Family Parishioners and Friends,

It is customary for the priests to visit the area hospitals and nursing homes. It is one of the things that we enjoy doing. However, we do not always know who is in the hospital or who is in the nursing home. Since the pandemic, we are finding that we are not getting the information as we did in the past.

I would like to recommend some things for your consideration to help facilitate this process. If you or a loved one are admitted to the hospital, please indicate that you are Catholic and from Holy Family Church, Syracuse. Secondly, please have someone notify that parish office that you (or a loved one) are in the hospital/nursing home. The parish is not notified by the hospital/nursing home, and it happens that people will say they were in the hospital, and we simply did not know about it. For nursing home patients, please notify the office of who is in the nursing home (and what nursing home they are in).

Please understand that when it comes to making visits, every institution is different. Due to COVID and various policies, most hospitals/nursing homes are limiting visitors or the number of visitors. Some require COVID testing and masks, others do not. As clergy, we have to respect the protocols at each institution. Recently, I went to visit a parishioner in a local facility, and I was not permitted to go in because visiting hours didn't start for another 30 minutes. It is the reality that we face today. We will do everything we can to make a pastoral visit. Again, please inform our parish office that you have been admitted to a hospital/nursing home and, if one of our priests cannot visit you, we will see if the chaplain can. Let's continue to ask God for continued peace and healing.
