GOSPEL REFLECTION

John 20: 19 -31

Today we conclude the Octave of Easter with Divine Mercy Sunday. Our eight day celebration of Easter ends with a spotlight on God's infinite mercy.

In today's gospel we see Jesus appear to all the disciples except for Thomas. We are not sure why Thomas was not with the others. Perhaps he was the only one brave enough to venture out into public or maybe he simply needed some fresh air. We also don't know why Jesus chose to appear to the disciples when Thomas was absent. Much like the events of our own lives, there is much uncertainty in why things happen like they do. What we do know is that Thomas met the others with skepticism when they told him they had seen the Lord.

When Jesus appears again, He does not rebuke Thomas, but instead invites him, saying, "Peace be with you...do not be unbelieving, but believe." Jesus even offers his very wounds to satisfy Thomas' doubt. Jesus demonstrates his mercy to Thomas by not allowing him to persist in doubt. Jesus didn't want Thomas' unbelief to extend, instead he wanted to transform his doubt into trust. Jesus has the same desire for each of us.

Today, we are invited to join the disciples in the upper room and meditate on mercy. In our daily lives are we believers in God's infinite mercy for us? Do we appreciate that God's infinite mercy is open to everyone and that we are called to share that mercy with others? Together let us pray for the courage to accept mercy and forgiveness in our own lives and the desire to share that mercy and forgiveness with others.
