

The diocesan Child and Youth Protection policy requires completing the initial Safe Environment training session upon the assumption of duties, employment, or volunteering whose ministry or role places them in regular contact with children, young people, or vulnerable adults. Re-certification every five years is required if you remain active in your ministry.

GOSPEL REFLECTION

John 20:1-9

Christ Is Risen! Indeed He Is Risen!

My friends, a Happy and Blessed Easter to you all!

In our Gospel today, we see Mary Magdalene being distraught as she finds the tomb empty and in sadness, assumes that the Body of her Lord had been stolen. We see Peter and the Beloved Disciple run to the tomb and discover the burial cloths. Peter does not yet understand, while the Beloved Disciple sees and believes. The Disciples of Jesus had not understood Jesus' own prophecy and the prophecies from the Hebrew Scriptures, that he would rise from the dead.

When the disciples, at different times in the New Testament, encounter the Risen Jesus, they move from incredulity and sadness to joy, hope, and freedom to move beyond fear. Then later, when they receive the Holy Spirit of the Risen Christ, they are strengthened and sent forth to proclaim the Good News of Jesus, cost what it may. While we do not know what happened to Mary Magdalene, we do know that all the disciples (except the Beloved Disciple), witnessed to Jesus, even to the shedding of their blood. While we may not have the same forms of martyrdom that the disciples endured, we share with them the same call to bear witness to Christ, and the same Risen Lord who meets us every day on our journey, if we are open to him and to his saving power.

And so I ask you: Where have you met the Risen Christ?

Be Blessed and Be a Blessing this Easter day and season, and every day and Season!
