The diocesan Child and Youth Protection policy requires completing the initial Safe Environment training session upon the assumption of duties, employment, or volunteering whose ministry or role places them in regular contact with children, young people, or vulnerable adults. Recertification every five years is required if you remain active in your ministry.

# **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

Matthew 14: 22 - 33

This week's gospel reading is one of the quintessential moments in the Bible – Jesus walking across the crashing waves, Peter calling out to join Him, successfully stepping across the water before wavering in his trust and sinking.

There are many lessons we can take away from this, but one in particular struck me – Jesus is calling us to **ACT**. When Peter steps out of his boat, he is not trying to escape the threat. He is stepping right into the chaos and danger of the tumultuous sea. But Jesus is there reshaping the view of what is possible!

While it is comfortable knowing that God is here with us in our safe corner of the world, we might also acknowledge that God can be encountered everywhere. Imagine how our faith might grow if we pushed our boundaries past what is safe and familiar and find God in those turbulent places where regular expectations and predictable endings don't apply. How can we be like Peter and step off our boat into the tumult and show God to others? Our faith calls us to be active.

Now more than ever, the world right outside our comfort zone needs our action. Just like the disciples in the boat, fear of the chaos and unknown is an instinctual reaction. This fear erupts because we assume how the story will end. But imagine how stepping into someone else's disorderly world could change their life and leave an indelible mark on your own. We can join Jesus and change what seems impossible, if only we find the courage to take that step out of our boat.
