Luke 1: 26 - 38

This is an overwhelming time of the year for me. Not because there is so much going on, but because of the emotions this time of year brings. How do we capture God's love as it shines through the Christmas story? How do we put into words the love we have for our children, parents, families, or friends? How do we express how much we miss loved ones who God has called home? We most certainly can't. This time of year tends to get to the core of the human experience - with happiness, sorrow, excitement, compassion, and a hundred other emotions all wrapped into one moment.
