GOSPEL REFLECTION

Mark 1: 12 - 15

In this weekend's Gospel we hear that "The Spirit drove Jesus out into the desert, and he remained in the desert for forty days..."

What do you think of when you bring to mind a desert?

For me, images of dry, hot, cracked ground come to mind. I think thoughts of thirst. The uncomfortably hot weather. Ultimately, and I think that many would agree with me, when we think of the desert, we bring to mind all that is lacking there. There isn't enough people, places, or things.

And yet, Jesus is led to the desert and remains there for forty days by the direction given to him by the Spirit. Why would the Spirit of God lead Jesus - or you and I - to enter the desert for forty days?

Lets reframe our thinking of the desert. Instead of thinking of the desert of a place lacking; let's instead, think of it as a place of abundance where we can recieve a blessing from God. When we have the opportunity to go to a place and recieve a blessing from God, then we are going to exactly where we need to be.

The Gospel story closes by reminding us that "the angels came and ministered to him."

This Lent, my prayer for you and I is that we might enter into the desert with Jesus looking for the abundant blessings of God. Remember that no matter what might come your way, Jesus is with you, and the Spirit of God will send you exactly what you need when you need it.
