Parish Collaboration

Dear Holy Family Parishioners and Friends,

Since January 2024, leadership from Holy Family Church leadership has been in meetings with other parishes in our area to look at how we can best provide pastoral care in our area with fewer clergy and fewer people. The parishes that make up our Pastoral Care Area (PCA) are, Holy Family Church, Fairmount, St. Joseph's Church Camillus, St. Michael/Peter Church, Onondaga Hill, Our Lady of Hope Church, Syracuse (they are already linked with St. Michael/Peter), St. Francis Xavier Church, Marcellus, St. Mary Church, Skaneateles, St. Patrick's Church, Jordan. In our meetings, we have been discussing how we can work together, share resources, and do all that we can to assist each other with caring for souls. We have discussed topics like the number of Masses we have, attendance at each Mass, staffing, sacramental programs and the number of people in our programs, finances, and much more. These discussions will continue as we go forward. Another topic we will discuss is our closeness to Solvay and Lakeland (St. Marianne Cope Parish) and the feasibility of collaborating with the two parishes that make up St. Marianne Cope.

As you can see, there is a lot for our consideration. It is good that these discussions take place and that we plan ahead. The reality that we all know is that this type of collaboration must take place. We have to work together. I am happy that we are sponsoring the Lenten Mission with St. Joseph's Church because it helps this process of collaboration and I know that much more needs to be done going forward. This is a very positive time for all of us as we look for ways to work together to spread the Kingdom of God! I will keep you posted as our talks progress. Please keep this process in your prayers.

GOSPEL REFLECTION

Mark 9: 2 - 10

The line from this weekend's Gospel that strikes me most is this: "From the cloud came a voice, "This is my beloved Son. Listen to him."

How often do I forget to listen?

Listening is so important in the life of the Christian disciple. How do we listen? In today's noisy world, full of Facebook posts and targeted social media ads, endless amounts of streaming services vying for our attention, news services providing clickbait titles, and all of our pressing relationships and responsibilities - how can we sift through all that and hear the voice of God?

It says in the Gospel, "Jesus took Peter, James, and John and led them up a high mountain apart by themselves."

Jesus leads them to be "apart by themselves." How often to we prioritize being apart by ourselves with Jesus? To actively choose to spend time alone with Him? This Gospel is a call to us during our Lenten journey to do just that - spend some time apart by ourselves with the Lord and just listen to him.

What does Jesus speak into your life? What is he trying to help you to understand or to realize? How is He calling your to change or move forward in your life? Does He say that He wants your to take some sort of action? Or maybe, He is simply speaking to you and saying, "I love you."

I'm not sure what the Lord will speak to you during this moment in your life and what you need to hear from him, but neither will you if you don't intentionally make time to listen to His voice. So, go and be apart by yourself with Jesus this week and listen to Him. God bless you.
