GOSPEL REFLECTION

Matthew 5: 13-16

This week's Gospel calls us to be **light to the** world and salt of the earth in reaching out to our brothers and sisters. This really strikes a chord with me as a deacon ordained to represent "Christ as Servant" out in the world!

When we think of Christian "ministry", we might focus on the duties of church authorities, the ordained, or those specially involved in church or parish activities. This Gospel passage, however, should shift that focus! Jesus is not speaking solely to a select few to carry out his mission to the world, but to all of us who follow him in faith.

Every Christian is a disciple of Jesus, actively engaged in his work. Our Baptism endows us with a status but equally endows us with a mission. By virtue of our Baptism, we are each called to serve, each called to be "light" to the world. It's up to us to spread the Gospel message and carry the healing wisdom of Jesus to all we meet as we help to build up God's kingdom here on earth.

Let's remember our first responsibility is to keep our own light shining brightly by embracing our faith and its practice. We can't share what we don't have ourselves! Then watch out for the multiple opportunities to allow your light to shine in the darkness of life all around you.

So, are you aware of the light you give off in your attitudes, words, and actions?

And are you alert to the impact you have or can have on other people's lives?
