Hope Appeal 2022 Update

Dear Friends,

As of December 31, 2022, Holy Family Church has raised \$172,510.00 of the \$122,084.26 (141%) Hope Appeal goal! This is incredible! Thank you so much for your generous support of this appeal and the far-reaching impact it has throughout the seven county Diocese of Syracuse. Since we have raised \$50,000 beyond our goal, all of that overage will come back to Holy Family Church for our use. Currently, 649 families out of 3,700 (roughly 18% of our parish) have made gifts to the Hope Appeal. The average gift per family is, \$265.81. There is a balance of \$14,187.74 due on pledges. Again, thank you for your generous donations to the appeal. Not only does it allow our Diocesan Church to do great things in the name of Jesus, but it is also the biggest fundraiser we have at Holy Family as we get so much back in overage. Thank you for making Jesus known to so many! God will reward us for all that we do to reveal His love, presence, and truth in our world!

GOSPEL REFLECTION

John 1: 29-34

I often wonder why this time of our Catholic year is called 'Ordinary Time'. There is nothing **ordinary** about the way Jesus lived His life and He doesn't expect us to be simply **ordinary** either.

In today's reading, John doesn't merely call Jesus the **Son of God**. He takes it even further and addresses Jesus as the **Lamb of God** – a clear connection to the sacrificial lamb. Jesus is one with sacrifice.

When you hear the word **sacrifice** what comes to mind? Is it a grand gesture like Iron Man flying a nuclear bomb into another dimension to save the world? Or more personal and small scale such as forgoing your morning trip to the coffee shop for a simple brewed cup of coffee from home? Myself, as a parent, I feel like sacrifice is part of everyday life. I long for the day when each meal isn't met with disdain and my car is not covered in stale snacks and sticky fingerprints.

But God wants more from us.

We are called to be a living sacrifice. What does a living sacrifice look like? It is love. I don't know about you, but love is at the root of all that is good in my life. If someone were to ask me why I am Catholic, the answer every time would be love. God loves me and provides me with all I could ever need and now I am accountable for bringing that love to others.

Consider challenging yourself to find ways that you can move beyond the ordinary. Be a living sacrifice and that beacon of God's love to everyone you encounter.
