Holy Family Church has had another successful Hope Appeal Campaign!

### Hope Appeal 2023

Holy Family Church's Hope Appeal goal for 2023 was \$122,000. Today, Holy Family has raised \$171,047.50, or 140% of our goal. This is absolutely astounding! Your generosity will allow the presence of Christ to be experienced by so many throughout our seven-county Diocese. Currently, 632 families out of 3,700 have made gifts or pledges to the appeal. The average gift per family is \$270.64. Since we surpassed our goal, 100% of the overage will return to Holy Family Church. So, if every pledge is paid off, Holy Family will receive nearly \$50,000 in overage. This makes the Hope Appeal the biggest fundraiser for our parish. If you have not given to the Hope Appeal, there is still time to do so. Every gift given to the Hope Appeal at this point comes back to us for our use. Again, thank you for your faith and your desire that the presence of Jesus be shared in our hospitals, nursing homes, by way of the Mass for shut-ins, at Catholic Charities, in our food pantries, soup kitchens, on our college campuses, in our Catholic Schools, through Catholic TV, the Catholic Sun, in our catechetical programs, in our pro-life programs, in prison ministry, in youth ministry, and in so many other ways! You are a blessing to many! God will repay each of us and our parish a hundredfold for our goodness done in His name!

# **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

John 1: 35 - 32

Last Sunday we celebrated the Epiphany, when the infant Jesus was visited by the magi. Today, we have entered Ordinary Time, and, in the Gospel, we are again presented with the adult Jesus. The Sundays and weeks of Ordinary Time lead us through the life if Christ, emphasizing his ministry and teachings so that we can grow in faith as one of his disciples. It makes sense that we should begin Ordinary Time by returning to the beginning of Jesus' public ministry and his calling of the first disciples. In fact, our readings this Sunday in general have a theme of vocation, of hearing the call of the Lord and responding properly.

True discipleship flows from Jesus' initiative. He speaks to us first, and we then have a choice in how we respond. The two disciples responding by remaining with him, and then one of them, Andrew goes a step further by sharing his encounter with Christ with his brother Simon, who is later known as Peter.

Though it is Andrew who brings Simon to Jesus, it is Jesus who again speaks first. Like his disciples, our relationship with God is a result of God's initiative and calling. We can choose whether we heed his call and follow or turn a deaf ear. I know what my choice is.
