GOSPEL REFLECTION

Matthew 4: 12-23

In the Gospel for this weekend, Jesus calls Peter, Andrew, James, and John to “**follow him.**” Interestingly, we learn that all four of these fishermen, immediately abandon their nets or their boat to follow Jesus. The Gospel goes to great lengths to let the reader know that these men quickly gave up what they were doing and began their journey with the Lord.

I find this interesting because the Lord calls us daily to follow him. When I think of that daily call of the Lord, I wonder how quick we are to let go of what we are doing so that we can truly take up the work of the Lord. I know, in my own life, that I might hear the Lord inviting me to participate in His mission, and my response can sometimes be, “Lord, let me finish what I am doing first.” Or “Lord, I am not capable of doing what your asking, please ask someone else.” I don’t know about you, but I can be pretty quick to come up with an excuse to ignore God’s daily invitations.

Today, let’s pray for the grace to follow the example of Peter, Andrew, James, and John as they quickly let go of what they are doing to follow Christ and look at what they were able to accomplish in His name!

May we offer this brief prayer daily:

God, help me to respond to your daily call to follow you, and let me do it without counting the cost or coming up with any number of excuses not to do what you are asking. Strengthen me to follow you without delay or reservation knowing that you will use me to make You known.
