GOSPEL REFLECTION

Mark 1: 21 - 28

The Gospel this weekend gives us the image of Jesus as a powerful teacher in the synagogue and as one who drives out unclean spirits. As a result, the people are quite impressed with him and they recognize there is something different about him. In fact, the Gospel tells us that, "His fame spread everywhere throughout the whole region of Galilee."

I love that line of the Gospel because it reminds us that when we have encounters with God, it is only natural that we want to speak about it. The people who witnessed Jesus preaching and doing great deeds didn't keep it to themselves. They told everyone.

One thing we can take away from this passage is the need, on our part, to go forth and tell people what God has done for us. I mean, how often do we start a conversation with, "Do you know what God did for me this week?" The reality is that God is constantly blessing us and constantly guiding us, but how quick are we to tell others about it? We can be very quick to share good news and bad news, but how quick are we to remind people of God's presence and love in our lives.

Last week, someone shared with me that they were very sick before Thanksgiving and God got them through their illness. I was impressed how they saw that their restored health was God working through them and all the great medical professionals that God put in their path.

Perhaps, this week, we can be more intentional about reminding ourselves and those around us that all is a gift from God!
