GOSPEL REFLECTION

Matthew 5: 1-12a

My friends, in our Gospel today, Matthew has Jesus begin his inaugural sermon as it were, known to most of us as the Sermon on the mount. In the passage we hear today, Jesus proclaims different categories of people to be “blessed.” Another way to translate “blessed” is “happy.” Our Blessed Lord is proclaiming the surest way to grow in true fulfillment, so we can be reasonably happy in this life, and supremely happy with the Lord forever in the life after life.

Typically in our world, and very often in our own minds at times, we believe that we find happiness in possessions, in looking for the next thrill, in getting ahead, in giving those who annoy us “what they deserve,” in avoiding conflict and so on. Our Lord shows us in the Gospel that in the divine worldview, true happiness is found in not being attached to what we have, in doing our best for him in everything we do, in trying to bring peace to each person with whom we come into contact, in trying to witness to the love and mercy and justice that Jesus came to bring (even when tough), in asking what we can bring into life instead of what we can get out of life.

In light of the true happiness which Jesus proclaimed, maybe we can ask ourselves this week: am I trying to get something out of life, or will I, with the grace of Jesus, seek instead to bring (in the words of Mother Teresa) “something beautiful for God,” into my life this week?
