Re-Certification Training Sessions: Tuesday, Sept. 12 or Wednesday, Sept. 27.

The diocesan Child and Youth Protection policy requires completing the initial Safe Environment training session upon the assumption of duties, employment, or volunteering whose ministry or role places them in regular contact with children, young people, or vulnerable adults. Re-certification every five years is required if you remain active in your ministry.

## GOSPEL REFLECTION

**Matthew 13: 24 - 43**

My friends, in today’s Gospel, we hear Jesus tell the parable of the wheat and the weeds in the field of the Lord. The wheat are those who live in the light of Christ’s Gospel, and the weeds are those dedicated to evil. The wheat and the weeds coexist in the same field of God, until they are separated on the Last day, and the weeds are burned and the wheat is gathered into the Father’s house. Much has been said about how this parable reminds us about how, this side of the Kingdom, the Church is made up of saints and sinners, and while this is true, there is another angle that I find particularly helpful, in looking at the parable.

Each one of us can be said to be a “field of God,” in microcosm. Within us, there are parts of us that are more under the Lordship of Jesus the Christ, and parts of us that need to be brought under his Kingship. We have shadows within us, and we have those parts of us that are in line with Christ’s light. We have weeds within us, and wheat. The Lord is always there for us, with his healing and forgiving sacraments of the Eucharist and Penance, so we can know of the saving power of his cross and resurrection, and so that more and more us will have the weeds within us transformed into being wheat. May we ask the Lord to change us and mold us, so we can be more and more who he wants us to be.
