Re-Certification Training Sessions: Tuesday, Sept. 12 or Wednesday, Sept. 27.

The diocesan Child and Youth Protection policy requires completing the initial Safe Environment training session upon the assumption of duties, employment, or volunteering whose ministry or role places them in regular contact with children, young people, or vulnerable adults. Re-certification every five years is required if you remain active in your ministry.

GOSPEL REFLECTION

Matthew 13: 44 - 52

The Gospel this weekend presents a series of parables that offer profound insights into the Kingdom of Heaven. The first two parables, the hidden treasure and the pearl of great price, teach us about the immeasurable value of the Kingdom. Just as a person would joyfully sell all they have to possess a priceless treasure, we are reminded of the necessity to prioritize the Kingdom above all else.

The parable of the net cast into the sea underscores the final judgment, where the righteous will be separated from the wicked. It urges us to live in accordance with God's principles, knowing that our actions have eternal consequences.

These passages encourage a reflective examination of our spiritual priorities. We must ask ourselves whether we truly recognize the Kingdom's significance in our lives and whether we are willing to make sacrifices to embrace it fully. They also emphasize God's sovereignty in the ultimate judgment, highlighting the need for righteous living.

As I ponder on these parables, I'm reminded of the importance of seeking spiritual wisdom and understanding. They encourage us to be like scribes, who bring forth both old and new treasures from the Word of God. This reminds me to continually seek God's truth, allowing it to transform my life and guide my actions.

In conclusion, Jesus' parables this weekend call us to value the Kingdom above all else, live righteously, and seek God's wisdom. It serves as a compelling reminder to orient our lives toward eternal truths and to share the message of the Kingdom with others.
