## MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Holy Family Parishioners and Friends,

This weekend you will notice that there are some things that are reappearing in church that we haven't seen in over three years due to COVID.

This weekend you will notice that the holy water fonts are back in church. At the beginning of COVID in March of 2020 they were removed out of concern that there could be a transmission of the virus through the use of the fonts. That concern has been alleviated and now they are back. Secondly, you will notice at the 10:30 AM Mass we will have two communal chalices for the distribution of the precious blood of our Lord. We have been given permission by the Diocese to reinstate the use of the communal chalice. Actually, dioceses across the country have been doing this for some time. Out of caution, we haven't done this until now. The reason we only have it at the 10:30 AM Mass is due to the reality that we do not have the number of Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (Eucharistic Ministers) to do it at all Masses. My hope is that we will be able to offer the communal chalice at all Masses when we have enough people to assist. Please know that you do not have to receive from the communal chalice, it is there for those who wish to do so. Additionally, you are not able to take the host and "dip it" (intinction is the formal name of this practice) into the chalice. That is not permitted in our faith tradition. I ask that you please respect this teaching as we transition back to the distribution of the precious blood. In the future, we will restore the offertory procession and begin seeking help to bring up the gifts of bread and wine at Mass.

Thank you for your patience and understanding over these past three years. Let's continue to pray for the health and well-being of all. Let's pray that there will be no more pandemics in our future!

# GOSPEL REFLECTION

**John 6: 51-58**

This weekend we are celebrating the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. Traditionally, this is referred to as Corpus Christi weekend. This celebration gives us the opportunity to celebrate the gift of the Holy Eucharist!

I think about the words of our Gospel today every time I receive Holy Communion, "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever..." The Gospel reminds us that Jesus gives us His body and blood as his promise to be with us forever. We are truly blessed! Additionally, this is something that we should not take for granted – that Jesus is truly present to us, body, blood, soul, and divinity in the Blessed Sacrament. All we have to do is think back three years ago, at the height of the pandemic when we couldn't receive Communion. So many of you told me that you missed Holy Communion so much!

One of my favorite hymns is the Panis Angelicus. The translation of the hymn is as follows, Thus Angels' Bread is made the Bread of man today: the Living Bread from heaven with figures dost away: O wondrous gift indeed! the poor and lowly may upon their Lord and Master feed. Thee, therefore, we implore, O Godhead, One in Three, so may Thou visit us as we now worship Thee; and lead us on Thy way, that we at last may see the light wherein Thou dwellest aye. Amen. Today, let's thank God for the gift of the body and blood of our Lord in the most Blessed Sacrament. Amen!
