GOSPEL REFLECTION

Matthew 10: 26 - 33

In my 40 years as a dentist, I have seen an increasing number of patients who, on their medical history forms, state they're being treated for clinical depression. It's much more common than we might think. It affects millions of people in various levels of severity and it seems like almost all of us know someone affected by it.

Depression can be triggered by a whole bunch of factors which can be internal (like chronic pain or genetics) or external (like the loss of a loved one, or stress). Often, depression can be caused by our perceptions. We become depressed not because of our problems, but because we believe our problems are insurmountable. We become depressed when we feel no one cares or that no one can help us rise above our troubles. When we lose faith that others are there to assist, we can give up.

The words of Jesus in today's Gospel are a powerful antidote to depression and a great support for us to carry on, no matter what hardships come our way. Jesus reveals God as a loving Father who has even the hairs of our head accounted for! We are not orphans in a world without meaning; we are beloved children of God in a world that has been designed for God's glory and our own. God is conscious of each of us and knows each one's needs. We never need to fear that our problems are hopeless, that no one can come to our aid. Our Protector is all-powerful and all-loving. As the prophet Jeremiah puts it so directly in today's reading:

"The Lord is with me..."
