OUTREACH & FOOD PANTRY

October 1 is the start of the fiscal year for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP). Maximum benefits, deductions, and income eligibility are adjusted based on the cost of living and reevaluated based on inflation every January. Some SNAP participants who receive Social Security may have had their SNAP benefits decreased or eliminated this year based on their new household income.

Statics for NYS from 10/21-9/22 are as follows:

2,839,326 persons received SNAP. The total cost for NYS was \$8,699,495,581, averaging \$441.69 per household.

GOSPEL REFLECTION

John 3:16-18

Do an internet search for 'most popular bible verse' and John 3:16 comes up repeatedly. Tattooed on people's bodies. Painted on athletes' faces. Tee shirts. Billboards. It is everywhere.

'For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not die but have eternal life.'

Why is this verse so widely celebrated above all the countless other options? I hope it is because we inherently know and embrace love as the most powerful force in our lives.

Love might be the most meaningful word in our language. Love is an immeasurable, uncontrollable emotion. We cannot adequately put it into words. No dictionary can adequately define 'love'.

The object of God's love is the WORLD. Not just the Christians. Not just the righteous. Not just those honored and revered in society. The WORLD. It is our job to make sure the WORLD feels that love.

On this Trinity Sunday, we are led to acknowledge and honor the mystery that is the Trinity. Perhaps we can look at it in terms of love. God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit are three joined in love. A love for us that is incomprehensible in itself.

I can't help but think of this verse from a favorite poem of mine: *'I love you because I know no other way than this: where I does not exist, nor you, so close that your hand on my chest is my hand, so close that your eyes close as I fall asleep.'* (Pablo Neruda, Sonnet XVII)

How lucky are we to have a God that loves us so, allowing us to love others in turn.
