GOSPEL REFLECTION

John 3: 14 - 21

"And this is the verdict, that the light came into the world and whoever lives the truth comes to the light, so that his work may be clearly seen as done by God. (Jhn3:19,21)

Today we celebrate Laetare Sunday this 4th week of Lent. Just as we celebrate Gaudete Sunday during

Advent, we wear the Rose-colored vestments to remind us to "Rejoice in the Lord"; to rejoice in his coming Passion where he fulfills our Baptismal promise and His Salvation story.

We also see and feel the physical impact on each of us as of Daylight-Saving time arrives today and we rejoice in our days growing longer and the darkness of winter soon leaving us as the Spring season heralds a new creation story as the physical world reawakens! We see the daylight grow before our eyes, by the minute and the hour it grows each day now and the question we should also be asking ourselves as well this Lenten season: Is the Light of Jesus Christ growing in our hearts as well minute by minute, hour by hour?

We receive the light of Jesus Christ in God's mercy extended to each of us. The whole world is raised up out of the darkness when God's own Son is sent into the world (Jhn3:16) and we as sinners are raised out of despair and offered a reprieve, for he arrives as Savior rather than judge. The whole world is offered the opportunity of new Life in Christ, and the forgiveness we have all experienced and the new life, the new light of Christ should shine brightly in each of us as we have all witnessed the Mercy of God in our lives.

So this Laetare Sunday, Be the light of Jesus Christ to everyone you come in contact with and let us all be grateful that we are the very sacrament of God's mercy. Rejoice!
