## MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

**Stations of the Cross** 

Friday, March 22, 2024 at 5:30 PM in Church.

Dear Holy Family Parishioners and Friends,

As you know, the Diocese of Syracuse filed for Chapter 11 Reorganization (Bankruptcy) in June of 2020 and reached a settlement in the amount of \$100 million in July 2023. While parishes did not file for Chapter 11 Reorganization, they did opt for protection under the Chapter 11 due to the reality that a number of parishes had cases against them. Holy Family Church has had three cases come forward (2 by priests and 1 by a lay employee). All these cases regarding Holy Family are from many years ago. All parishes have been asked to contribute to the Victims Trust Fund (the overall payout in the bankruptcy). In doing so, this prevents us from having to go to court for the three cases. As you can imagine, the legal fees and the potential payout could be detrimental to our parish. It has already been noted that parishes would pay \$45 million of the \$100 million to the Victims Trust Fund. The amount that Holy Family Church will pay into this fund is \$49,700. You may hear that other parishes are paying less or more. This number was determined by a percentage of our unrestricted savings. No money from collections, our restricted savings, our capital campaign, our Hope Appeal, or our Hope Appeal overage is being used. The amount we are paying is roughly 24% of our unrestricted funds. I know that this is difficult news, but as a Catholic family it is our moral obligation to provide reparation and share a role in bringing healing and reconciliation to the survivors. Please join me in prayer for all survivors of abuse of any kind, especially those that suffered abuse at the hands of trusted people in our Church. Also, let's pray and work together to ensure that this never happens again to anyone in our Church and outside of our Church!

# **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

#### John 12:20-33

In today's Gospel, we encounter a profound moment where some Greeks come to Philip, expressing the desire to see Jesus. This simple request sets in motion a series of events that culminate in Jesus revealing the purpose of his mission on earth.

The arrival of the Greeks symbolizes the universal nature of Jesus' message. Up until this point, Jesus had primarily ministered to the Jewish people, but now, with the arrival of the Greeks, we see that his message is meant for all people, regardless of their background or nationality.

This affirms to us Jesus came not just for a select few, but for the salvation of the whole world.

Interesting, notice Philip and Andrew's response. Instead of immediately bringing the Greek pilgrims to Jesus, they pause and consult with each other. This moment of hesitation can be seen as a reflection of our own reluctance to fully embrace Jesus' message. Logic doesn't produce faith.

How often do we overthink our faith? We apply our limited logic to the power of faith.

When Philip and Andrew bring the request of the Greek pilgrims to Jesus, Jesus begins to speak of his pending death and resurrection. This reminds us that Jesus' ultimate purpose is to offer himself as a sacrifice for all of humanity.

Brothers and sisters in Christ, on this fifth Sunday of Lent, let us be reminded of the universal nature of Jesus' message and be willing to step out in faith and bring others to encounter the saving love of Jesus Christ. Don't think or feel; don't rationalize; rather, immerse yourself in the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.
