GOSPEL REFLECTION

Matthew 14:1-15, 47

On Palm Sunday, a line always catches my attention: "Jesus willingly gave himself up to death." This is a powerful line from the Mass and it reminds us that Jesus, out of love for us, sacrificed his life for us.

Several years ago, I was in the Holy Land and I had the opportunity to pray in the Garden of Gethsemane. It sits on a hillside and you look out over the valley you can see the other hill and the City of Jerusalem. As our tour guide pointed out, when Jesus was praying in the Garden of Gethsemane, it was night and it was dark outside. The guide noted that, as Jesus looked over to Jerusalem, he would have seen the lights of those coming to arrest him. Jesus knew they were coming to get him and ultimately put him to death. Jesus didn't run, instead, he prayed in the Garden until they came to get him. Jesus willingly gave himself up to death for the sake of our salvation.

As we reflect on this, we might ask ourselves, what is it in my life that I would willingly sacrifice for the greater glory of God or the well-being of others?

This Holy Week, let's ask God what He wants us to let go of – to sacrifice – so that we can reveal His love to a world that desperately needs God's presence, goodness, love, and Easter joy!
