### MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

#### Dear Friends,

Several have asked me where we stand regarding the annual Hope Appeal 2023. You may remember our parish has a goal of \$122,000 and as of today, our parish has raised \$180,156. This is absolutely astounding! It is our best Hope Appeal campaign ever! Thank you so much for your generosity and support. It is a testimony to the faith that you possess and the faith is alive and well at Holy Family.

Just to give you an overview of the Hope Appeal by the numbers. As you can see we raised \$58,000 above our goal. We get to keep all of the overage. We raised 147.57% of our goal. As of today, 688 families of 3,700 have donated to the annual appeal. The average gift per family is \$269.69. The most important thing is that our parish contributed \$122,000 for so many needy ministries in the Diocese of Syracuse. Our goodness will support Catholic Charities, food pantries, soup kitchens, youth and young adult programs, pro-life ministries, Catholic Schools, family ministries, marriage preparation programs, vocation promotion, The Catholic Sun, Catholic TV, hospital and nursing home chaplains, college campus ministry, Mass for shut-ins, and much, much more! Your donations allow the mission of Jesus to carry on! Again, thank you, thank you! God will bless us in abundance for all that we do in His name!

# **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

John 11: 1-45

Everything happens for a reason.

This concept was a constant presence when I was growing up – a mantra that my mother firmly stood by as her mother had and her mother before that. I think that mindset gave me a sense of peace through my childhood and into my adult years. But in hindsight, that was a coping strategy and, more critically, an avoidance tactic that allowed me to separate my struggles from my faith.

The trouble came when, at the age of 28, I became a mother to a critically ill baby. This was the child I had prayed for and dreamed of for years, but this was NOT the way I thought I would become a mother. I was scared and confused and grieving what I thought my experience should have been. In those moments, I could not accept that everything happens for a reason. What could the reason have possibly been? Why would God have purposefully saddled me with this mountain?

In this weekend's Gospel, I think we see one of the most important moments in Jesus' life and ministry. It was not when he commanded his friend, who had been dead for four days, to rise and leave the tomb. It was with these two words: *Jesus wept*. In that moment it was clear: Jesus felt what we feel. He was in pain. He was grieving. He was hurting and confused. For that reason, I know he does not wish pain and grief upon us. But he IS there with us. There does not have to be a reason we are living these experiences. Just take comfort that Jesus knows our pain and is walking alongside us in our journey.

Maybe as we wrap up these last couple of weeks of Lent we can pause to reflect on that power of suffering in community with others. We are suffering along with Jesus in our Lenten journeys as he is walking along with us. There is no solitude in suffering.
