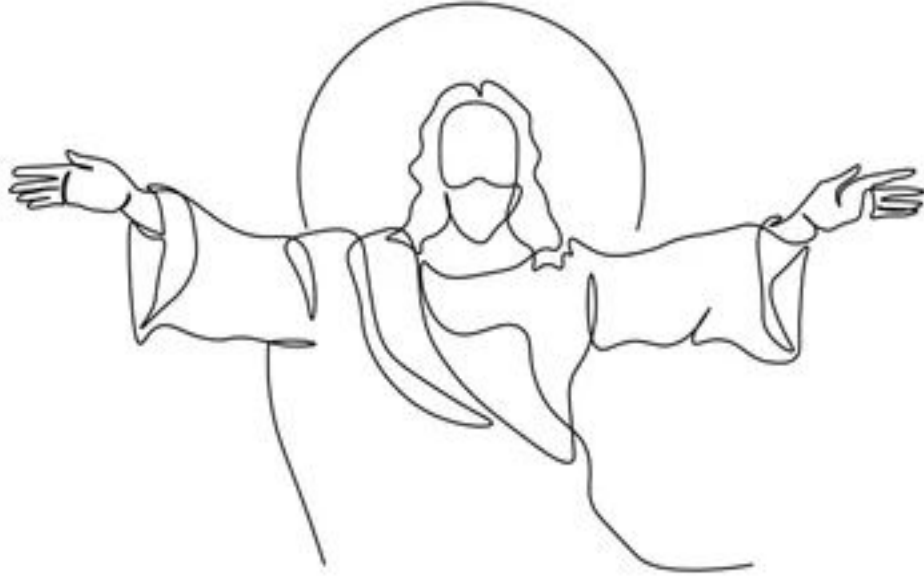

# GOSPEL REFLECTION

**John 14: 15-21**

“If you love me, you will keep my commandments.”
