# GOSPEL REFLECTION

**John 20:19-23**

This weekend we celebrate Pentecost, marking the day the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles. We also celebrate Memorial Day, remembering all of those who have given their lives for our country.

A few weeks ago I was humbled to meet 1-on-1 with some of our confirmation students. We spent time talking about the gifts of the Holy Spirit and one in particular: fortitude. While fortitude is sometimes called courage, it goes beyond what we normally think of as courage. Fortitude empowers us to overcome our fears and take risks as Catholic Christians, allowing us to stand up for what is right, even if it means rejection or physical harm.

In today's gospel we see the Apostles gathered together in a locked room "for fear of the Jews" when our Lord appears. Contrast that with our first reading and we see those same Apostles courageously empowered by the Holy Spirit proclaiming the good news of Jesus.

Together let's ask the Holy Spirit for the same gift of fortitude that empowered the Apostles to be strong witnesses of faith in everyday life. Maybe it's taking on a health diagnosis we didn't see coming, courageously forgiving someone who has hurt us, or even acting with love at Wegmans when we've had an exhausting day.

As we remember this weekend all those who have given their lives for our country, let's also remember the fortitude and courage our fallen heroes must have had to do what was right, what was required of them, and what makes our freedom possible.

Let us together turn to the Holy Spirit in thanksgiving and for continued strength!
