In these emails/text messages, people are being asked to respond with gift cards, or saying one of the priests or deacons needs your advice. DO NOT RESPOND. These are scam messages trying to lure in an unsuspecting victim to ask you for money or gift cards.

Holy Family Priests/Deacons and Parish Office will never solicit anything from you in this manner. Whenever you are suspicious of one of these messages, please delete it and DO NOT RESPOND. Additionally, you are encouraged to report it to the email company/social media platform/phone company/or local authorities.

It is sad that our world is overrun with people who have turned to scamming others. These are the types of scams they attempt to carry out daily. Please be diligent and pray for the conversion of the scammers.

Hope Appeal 2023

To date Holy Family Church has raised \$90,000 of its goal of \$122,000. That's roughly 74% of the goal. Currently, 336 families have contributed to the annual appeal. As you can see, we are still a long way off from achieving our goal. To all who have given, thank you for your generosity! Every family is asked to give the appeal a minimum gift of \$150 (\$.41 a day or \$12.50 a month). If you can afford to give more, please give what your heart tells you to give. If you cannot afford the minimum gift, give what you can give because every gift counts.

Again, thank you for your generosity to the Hope Appeal. Through your gift, you reveal Jesus to others in our seven-county Diocese. Thank you for bringing Jesus to others and thank you for sharing your faith and being an inspiration to so many!



GOSPEL REFLECTION

Matthew 22: 34 - 40

"Teacher, which commandment in the law is the greatest?" He said to him, 'You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the greatest and the first commandment. The second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

In the Gospel, the Pharisees approach Jesus and ask him which law is the greatest and he responds by telling them to love the Lord with their whole being. He doesn't stop there; he goes on to say that the second commandment is to love your neighbor as yourself.

As we reflect on this Gospel, we probably recognize that it is easy for us to say, "Yes, I love the Lord with all my hear, all my soul, and all my mind!" However, Jesus says if that is truly the case...if we truly love the Lord with our entire being, then that should be demonstrated in how we love others. At the heart of this very Gospel is our need to reflect on how we treat others.

Let's pray asking God to help us to love Him and to show that love by how we reach out to others. It is not easy to treat others the way we wish to be treated. One scholar says that is the case because we need to love ourselves the way God looks at us and loves us, unconditionally. Then, from here, to go forth and extend love to others. St. Claire of Assisi once said, "St. Clare of Assisi: "We become what we love, and who we love shapes what we become."

Who do we love? We love Jesus! Let's ask Jesus to shape us into loving people that reveal God's love to the world.
