### MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Hope Appeal 2023

Thank you for your generosity to the annual Hope Appeal. The Hope Appeal reveals the love and compassion of our Lord throughout our seven-county Diocese. Your gift to the annual appeal supports the Mass for shut-ins, hospital and nursing home chaplains, college campus ministry programs, faith formation programs, youth and young adult programs, right-to-life activities, vocation promotion, Catholic School tuition assistance, and so much more. Every parish in the Diocese of Syracuse has a Hope Appeal goal; our Hope Appeal goal is \$122,000. In an effort to achieve the goal, I would like to suggest that every family in the parish consider making a minimum gift/or pledge to the Hope Appeal of \$150.00 (averages out to \$12.50 a month of \$.41 a day). If you can afford more than the minimum suggested gift per family, please do so. If you cannot give the minimum gift per family, please know that anything you do will be a big help. Every gift counts! I want to be totally transparent and let you know that all Hope Appeal gifts/pledges are restricted gifts and can only be used for the purposes of the Hope Appeal. If we exceed our goal, all of the overages will come back to Holy Family for our use. Last year, we received \$62,000 in overage and we have used that money for additional projects around the parish. The Hope Appeal is the biggest fundraiser for our church community. So, as you can see, a gift to the Hope Appeal is a gift to Holy Family. On behalf of all impacted by the appeal, I thank you for your great generosity and support! Your goodness makes Holy Family Church a leader in the Hope Appeal, and it is a great testimony to the faith of our parish! Thank you and I know God will repay us a hundredfold for our generosity! Please make your gift or pledge as soon as possible.

# **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

Matthew 20: 1 - 6a

Is life always fair? It would seem not. We have all experienced situations in life when we felt as though we were cheated. Children are especially sensitive to this and will often complain to a parent when they feel as though they have been treated unjustly. From an earthly perspective, it is true that life is not always fair. But we really shouldn't live from an earthly perspective. We are called to live according to the divine perspective. From that perspective, everything is fair in the end, and true justice is handed out to everyone.

The parable we read today presents to us the scenario in which God has chosen to bestow His grace and mercy in abundance to all who turn to Him. We can never earn the right to His mercy. Nothing we can do will ever give us the right to the gift of eternal salvation. Therefore, this parable especially challenges us to look at Heaven and the life of grace on earth from the perspective of "gift." All is a gift from God.

Only when we comprehend God's goodness and infinite generosity will we be able to overcome our temptations toward jealousy and selfishness. If you find that you have jealousy, or judge others from the perspective of earthly justice, work to change that perspective so that your heart's deepest desire is to see God bestow the fullness of mercy upon everyone in this world when they turn to Him. In the end, today's Gospel is a lesson in humility and to live the life of blessings and grace He gave you.
